Charter

Article I: Name and Purpose

Section 1: Name

1.1 The name of this organization shall be Venezia Fan Club USA “Duncan Niederauer”.

Section 2: Purpose

1.2 The purpose of the club is to promote the enjoyment of football, foster camaraderie among members, and support the appreciation of the sport.

Article II: Membership

Section 1: Eligibility

2.1 Membership is open to individuals who share an interest in football and agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the club.

Section 2: Admission

2.2 Prospective members shall submit an application and, upon approval by the club, become members upon payment of any required membership fees.

Section 3: Rights and Responsibilities

2.3 Members have the right to participate in club activities and events. Members are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and sportsmanlike manner.

Article III: Club Structure

Section 1: Officers

3.1 The club shall have elected officers, including a President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer, responsible for the administration of the club.

Section 2: Elections

3.2 Officers shall be elected annually by a vote of the membership. Nominations may be made by any member in good standing.

Article IV: Meetings

Section 1: Regular Meetings

4.1 Regular meetings shall be held monthly and may include discussions, events planning, and other club-related activities.

Section 2: Special Meetings

4.2 Special meetings may be called by the President or upon the request of a majority of the members.

Article V: Finances

Section 1: Dues

5.1 The club may establish membership dues. Changes to dues must be approved by a majority vote of the membership.

Section 2: Financial Management

5.2 The Treasurer shall maintain accurate financial records, and the club's finances shall be subject to an annual audit.

Article VI: Amendments

Section 1: Proposal

6.1 Any member may propose amendments to this constitution. Proposed amendments shall be submitted in writing and discussed at a regular meeting.

Section 2: Approval

6.2 Amendments require a two-thirds majority vote of the members present at a meeting where the amendment is discussed.

Article VII: Dissolution

Section 1: Dissolution

7.1 In the event of dissolution, any remaining assets shall be distributed to a designated charitable organization.

Article VIII: Ratification

Section 1: Ratification

8.1 This constitution shall be ratified by a two-thirds majority vote of the members present at the inaugural meeting.
